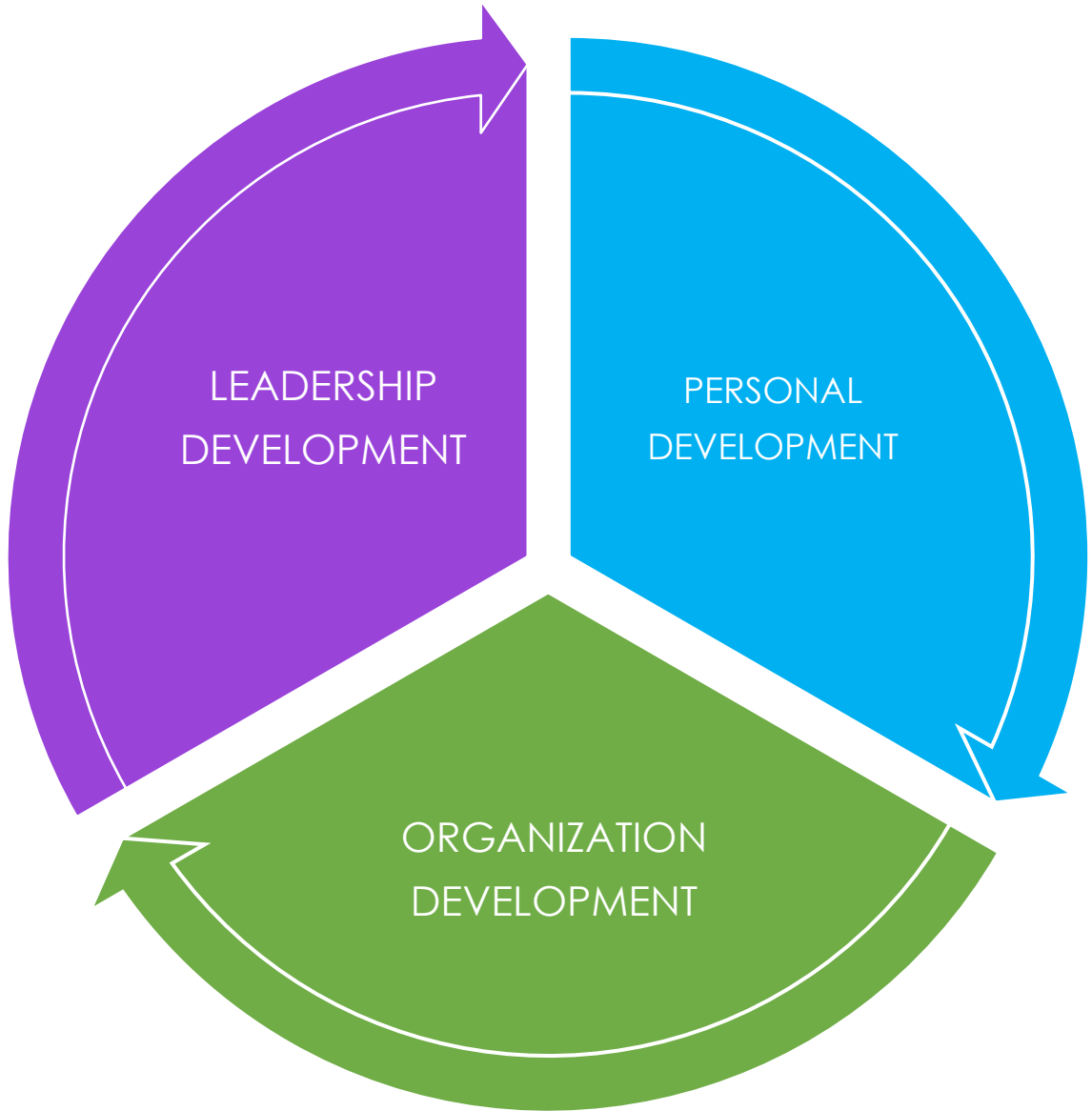
Righteous Oaks was founded to work with leaders and organizations to develop and implement systems and structures that will enable their employees to thrive and facilitate the achievement of organizational goals.

WHAT TO EXPECT

THE PROCESS

- **Focus** – Helps narrow things down to the basics. Helps eliminate distractions
- **Integration** – Helps you live out your vision/purpose daily by integrating it into all facets of your life
- **Action (Planning)** – Helps you live out your kingly role by working with God to identify and do your part even as you trust Him to do His part.

KEY PILLARS

- **Prayer** – Prophetic intercession and prayers of agreement to harness the power of the Holy Spirit in attaining your vision
- **Guidance** – Spirit-directed guidance based on biblical principles/God's word
- **Direction** - Direction based on an understanding of your personality/seasons that is tailor made for you as an individual

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

Step 1:

Using the attached template as a guide write out your vision, mission and life goals following the simple instructions given.

Step: 2

From the guidelines provided set your personal short term goals (3 to 6 months) that will take you closer to your vision through small incremental steps

Step: 3

Do a monthly or quarterly review to evaluate your progress.
